



## Tips for Talking with Your Students about i-Ready Diagnostic 2

### Tips for preparing your students

- Give each student his/her Overall Scaled Score from Diagnostic 1.
- Set a Class Goal for how many points you want each student to gain.
- Write it down! Use a goal-setting sheet similar to the one in the webinar.

### Reminders for your students

- This NOT a test, it is NOT for a grade, and you can neither pass nor fail the diagnostic.
- You are only competing with yourself to show me how much you are learning in my class.
- Diagnostics are not timed, so take your time. The program will know if you rush. Students who show up on the rush report will have to take the test again.

### Incentive ideas

- Drawing from the names of every student who improves on their Diagnostic 1 score to win a prize
- Prizes for students who meet the class goal (number of scaled score growth points set by the teacher)
- Rewards for students who exceed the class goal
